2018 NOTICE OF RACE



1. RULES

These races will be governed by the rules, as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020. One-design class rules shall apply. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions govern.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising shall be limited to Class A, unless otherwise directed by class rules or a class's Olympic status.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 Classes given starts will be Stars, Ensigns, Ideals and any other class of three or more boats by prior arrangement with the race committee.

3.2 Contestants shall register with their respective class fleets, which shall set and collect all fees.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1 The first warning signal each day will be made at 0930 hrs, unless amended in the schedule below.

4.2 The Stars shall be designated as Class I on the course board. The Ensigns shall be designated as Class II on the course board, Ideal 18 will be designated as Class III on the course board. All other classes will be assigned a Roman numeral designation (IV, V, VI etc.) as necessary. The planned order of starts for the first race of the day is Class I (Stars), Class II (Ensigns), Class III (Ideal 18) and Class IV, V, VI etc. (any other classes). Starting sequences will not be given for absent classes. Class numbers (I, II, III, etc.) shall be used for posting courses on the course board.

4.3 If the race committee intends to start another race for a class, it will display code flag R (with no sound) and the class flags(s) of the class(es) having another race, while boats are finishing.

4.4 Races are planned for the following dates:

June 17 – 1 Races

June 24 – 2 Races

July 1 – 2 Races

July 8 – 2 Races (1600)

July 15 – 2 Races (1600)

July 22 – 2 Races

July 29 – 2 Races

August 5 – 2 Races

August 12 – 2 Races

August 19 – 2 Races

August 26 – 2 Races

September 2 – 2 Races

September 9 – 2 Races

4.5 There is one long race planned for Stars on each date set forth in Section 4.4.

4.6 The number of races planned for Ensigns and Ideals each day is set forth in Section 4.4.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at www.centerport-yc.org, www.northportyachtclub.com and from the race committee.

6. COURSES

The courses will be set in Northport and Huntington Bays and will be described fully in the sailing instructions.

7. PROTESTS

The protest procedure will be described in the sailing instructions. The person who shall be notified and with whom written protests or requests for redress shall be filed is:
